

2025 VOLUNTEER COMMITTEE DESCRIPTIONS

9 & 18 to Scoring Shuttle: Shuttle players, caddies and walking scorers at the end of their round from Dye's Valley to the Perch for scoring. Solely shuttles for after the round is finished (not at the turn during the round)

Location: Dye's Valley at TPC Sawgrass only

Active: Thursday – Sunday

Admissions / Will Call: Assist with checking for proper admission credentials, scanning tickets, distributing pairing guides and provide general information to spectators.

Location: Dye's Valley at TPC Sawgrass only

Active: Thursday – Sunday

Announcers: Introduce players to the crowd as they begin play at either #1 tee or #10 tee. Strong public speaking skills and appropriate voice/inflection required. *Please note: there is a security code needed in order to register for this committee. Please reach out to the Committee Chair to obtain the code.*

Location: Both Dye's Valley at TPC Sawgrass and Sawgrass Country Club

Active: Thursday - Sunday

Commissary: Assist in the distribution of all tournament materials during tournament week and leading up to event. In addition, must maintain and distribute supplies, refreshments, and water for players, caddies, and volunteers during the tournament. Please note that volunteers on this committee may have shifts at both Dye's Valley Course at TPC Sawgrass and/or Sawgrass Country Club. HEAVY LIFTING IS REQUIRED, VERY ACTIVE DUTY. Please note: there is a security code needed in order to register for this committee. Please reach out to the Committee Chair to obtain the code.

Location: Both Dye's Valley at TPC Sawgrass and Sawgrass Country Club

Active: Advance Weekend - Sunday

Competition Support - Walking Scorers: The Walking Scorer role is a prestigious and critical ShotLink volunteer position that requires mental and physical stamina, attention to detail, and a thorough understanding of the game of golf. The walking scorer accompanies a group of up to 3 players in order to keep their score, track specific statistics, and provide real-time data that informs all aspects of the ShotLink system. Walking scorers should have the physical ability to easily keep pace with their group across all 18 holes without a break and in varying weather conditions (for reference, 18 holes will vary from 5-6 miles or roughly 12,000 steps). They should be comfortable using the handheld digital device they will be issued for data capture, as well as the voice radio with a headset that allows for constant communication with the ShotLink staff.

Please note: there is a security code needed in order to register for this committee. Please reach out to the Committee Chair to obtain the code.

Requirements to be a Walking Scorer:

- Must complete a 1 hour online training course
- Must attend a 1 hour in-person training that occurs prior to tournament week
- Must complete ShotLink disclosure form
- Must be 18 or older
- Must be available to volunteer all 4 tournament days

Location: Both Dye's Valley at TPC Sawgrass and Sawgrass Country Club

Active: Wednesday - Sunday

Darlene's Diner: Darlene's Diner is located in Volunteer Headquarters and is exclusively for credentialed volunteers, staff and Caddies. Volunteers on this committee will assist with full food and beverage operations within the volunteer dining area.

Location: Dye's Valley at TPC Sawgrass only

Active: Monday - Sunday

Disabled Guest Services/ Volunteer Shuttle: Provide cart transportation for volunteers to and from headquarters and Dye's Valley. Also assist by request, for disabled spectators to and from the bus drop at the main entrance and disabled parking to designated areas on the golf course. Shifts are outside in direct sunlight.

Location: Dye's Valley at TPC Sawgrass only

Active: Thursday - Sunday

Facilities: Assist with player fencing, set-up of venues, tournament set up and other various projects as necessary. Volunteers will also rope and stake the course and all auxiliary areas as required with the objective of maximizing spectator viewing. Volunteers on this committee will need to be available prior to tournament week to assist with pre-tournament projects. Please note that volunteers on this committee may have shifts at both Dye's Valley Course at TPC Sawgrass and/or Sawgrass Country Club. *Please note: there is a security code needed in order to register for this committee. Please reach out to the Committee Chair to obtain the code.*

Location: Both Dye's Valley at TPC Sawgrass and Sawgrass Country Club

Active: Advance of Tournament - Sunday

Gallery Management: Volunteers will protect the competition inside the ropes by managing the flow of all on site personnel outside the ropes (manage gallery noise and crosswalks, etc). Volunteers will mainly assist with locating ball positions and identifying situations where a player's shot might be obstructed. They may be stationed at each tee, landing areas, putting greens and crosswalks.

Location: Both Dye's Valley at TPC Sawgrass and Sawgrass Country Club

Active: Thursday – Sunday

Parking: Operate and control proper access and flow to all parking areas located in the on-site parking lots.

Players, Volunteers, Caddies and Media will have designated parking tags.

Location: Dye's Valley at TPC Sawgrass only

Active: Monday - Sunday

Player & Caddie Services: Volunteers will assist with professional caddie services, such as caddie bib assembly, distribution and collection, throughout tournament week. Volunteers on this committee will also assist with player services as needed throughout tournament week.

Location: Both Dye's Valley at TPC Sawgrass and Sawgrass Country Club

Active: Wednesday – Sunday

Shuttles Vans: Volunteers on this committee will assist by driving 12-passenger vans for players, caddies, player families and volunteers to and from the TPC Sawgrass Clubhouse to both the Dye's Valley Course and Sawgrass Country club. Drivers must be 25 years of age and provide Driver's License information along with a Motor Vehicle Record Information form.

Location: Dye's Valley at TPC Sawgrass

Active: Thursday - Sunday

Standard Bearers: Accompany each group of players during play and display their scores in relation to par on a cumulative basis. They must be able to carry the standard (weight approximately 5 to 7 pounds) for the length of the course and must understand basic stroke counting. Volunteers for this committee should have the physical ability to easily keep pace with their group across all 18 holes without a break and in varying weather conditions (for reference, 18 holes will vary from 5-6 miles or roughly 12,000 steps). Shifts are outside and in direct sunlight and the elements. Standard Bearer volunteers must be no younger than 14 on Monday December 8, 2025. Youth volunteers are not eligible for a golf voucher.

Location: Dye's Valley at TPC Sawgrass only

Active: Thursday – Sunday

Tournament Support: The Tournament Support Committee will assist in many different capacities throughout the week including but not limited to filling in on any committee that requires additional assistance on either course, assisting in Volunteer Headquarters with uniform distribution, sales and upkeep, and being a Spotter for the Golf Channel on Saturday and Sunday. Those wishing to be a Spotter must select both Saturday and Sunday all day shifts. Actual times for Spotters will be at the direction of the Golf Channel.

Location: Dye's Valley at TPC Sawgrass only

Active Monday – Sunday.

Volunteer HQ / Apparel: Inventory and distribute volunteer apparel and credentials. Duties will include the management of uniform distribution area, apparel exchanges and returns. Volunteers will work closely with the supply distribution committee to make sure that Volunteer Village is always stocked with appropriate materials and supplies. Volunteers will assist in the general upkeep and appearance of the Volunteer Headquarters.
